The Department of Community and Cultural Affairs invites submissions for the second volume of the *Bermuda Anthology of Poetry*. With the publication this anthology, the Department seeks to promote and encourage the work of our local wordsmiths and celebrate the development of this craft.

### **Rules and Regulations:**

- Author must be Bermudian or a Bermuda resident.
- A maximum of eight poems per author may be submitted.
- Please submit only original, previously unpublished poetry.
- Only the author is permitted to submit their work.
- Any poems in another language must include an English translation
- No profanity will be included

All submissions will be reviewed by an independent agent for literary merit; all decisions by the agent regarding inclusion in the anthology are final.

### **Guidelines for Submission:**

All poems must be submitted no later than Friday, 2 April, 2010. Submissions should be accompanied by a separate form, including a short biography (50-150 words), and contact information (including name, address, telephone number, email address, and title(s) of submissions). Submissions should also include a signed copy of a release form authorizing publication. Materials should be submitted in an envelope with a hard copy of the documents. Only typed submissions will be accepted.
