5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

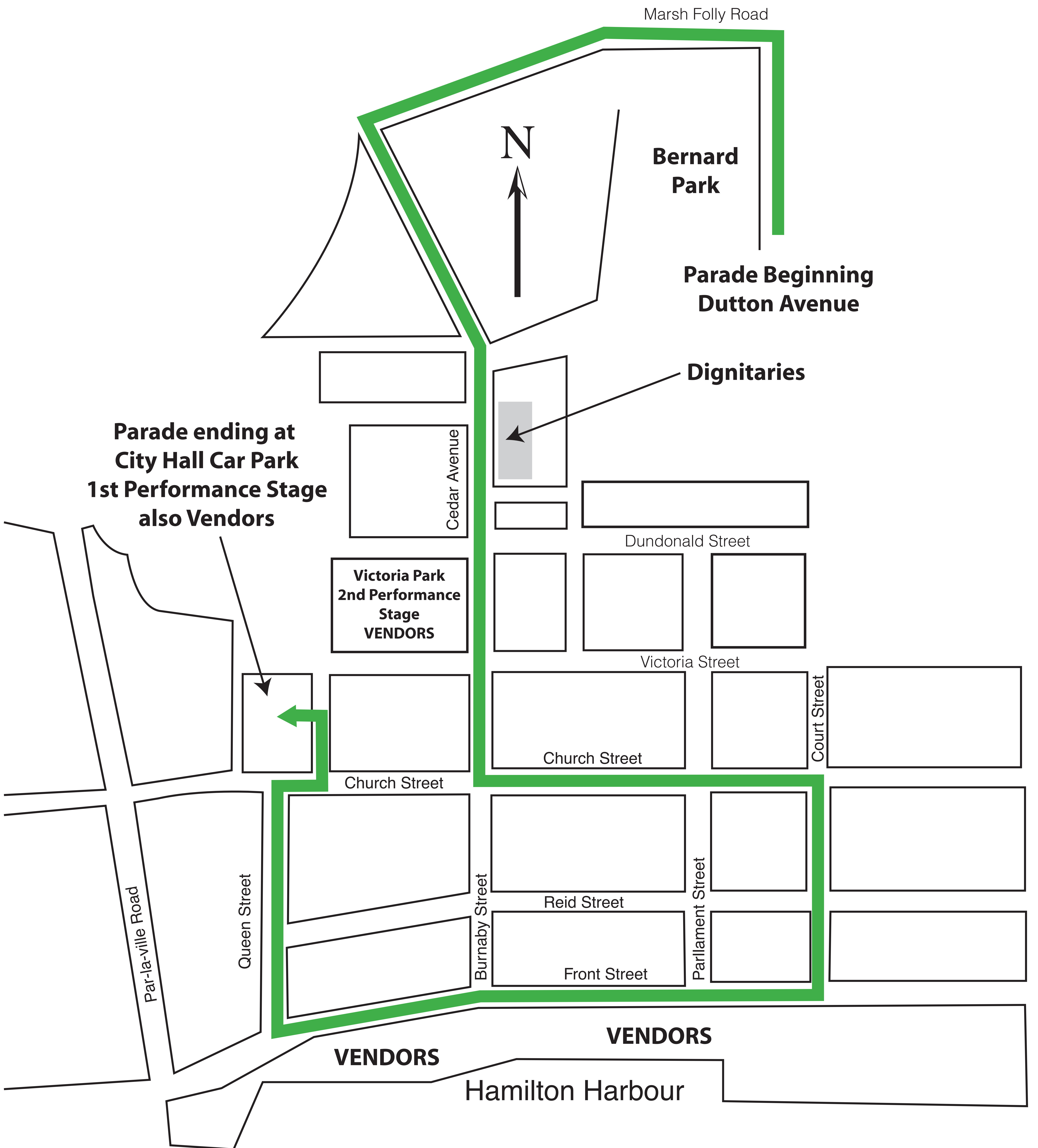
VENUE: The Number Six Cruise Passenger Terminal, Front Street
